

Clubhouse Rules

The HBYC Clubhouse represents the hard work of our membership and exists for their enjoyment. We rely on common courtesy and good sense as our primary guide for users and hope that a few simple rules will be sufficient.

1. The clubhouse is for the use of members, their accompanied guests and family only. The member is fully responsible for his/her guests and family members conduct and must be on-premises at all times during their occupancy.
2. No-Smoking policy is in effect throughout the clubhouse facility.
3. Each member is responsible for prompt clean up after his/her use of the facility.
4. Minors are not permitted to consume any alcoholic beverages on the premises nor are they to be seated at the bar.
5. No loud or offensive conversation or music is permitted in the clubhouse. No offensive apparel is to be worn on premises.
6. Alcoholic beverages are the personal property of the Member and are permitted in the clubhouse provided that their use is in moderation consistent with the 'family atmosphere' of the yacht club and marina.
7. Private parties or events are not permitted without the consent of the Rules committee. The clubhouse shall be kept available to all members during boating season (May 1 through Sept. 30) on Friday, Saturday and Sundays.

We hope that with good sense and courtesy additional burdensome rules will be unnecessary.
